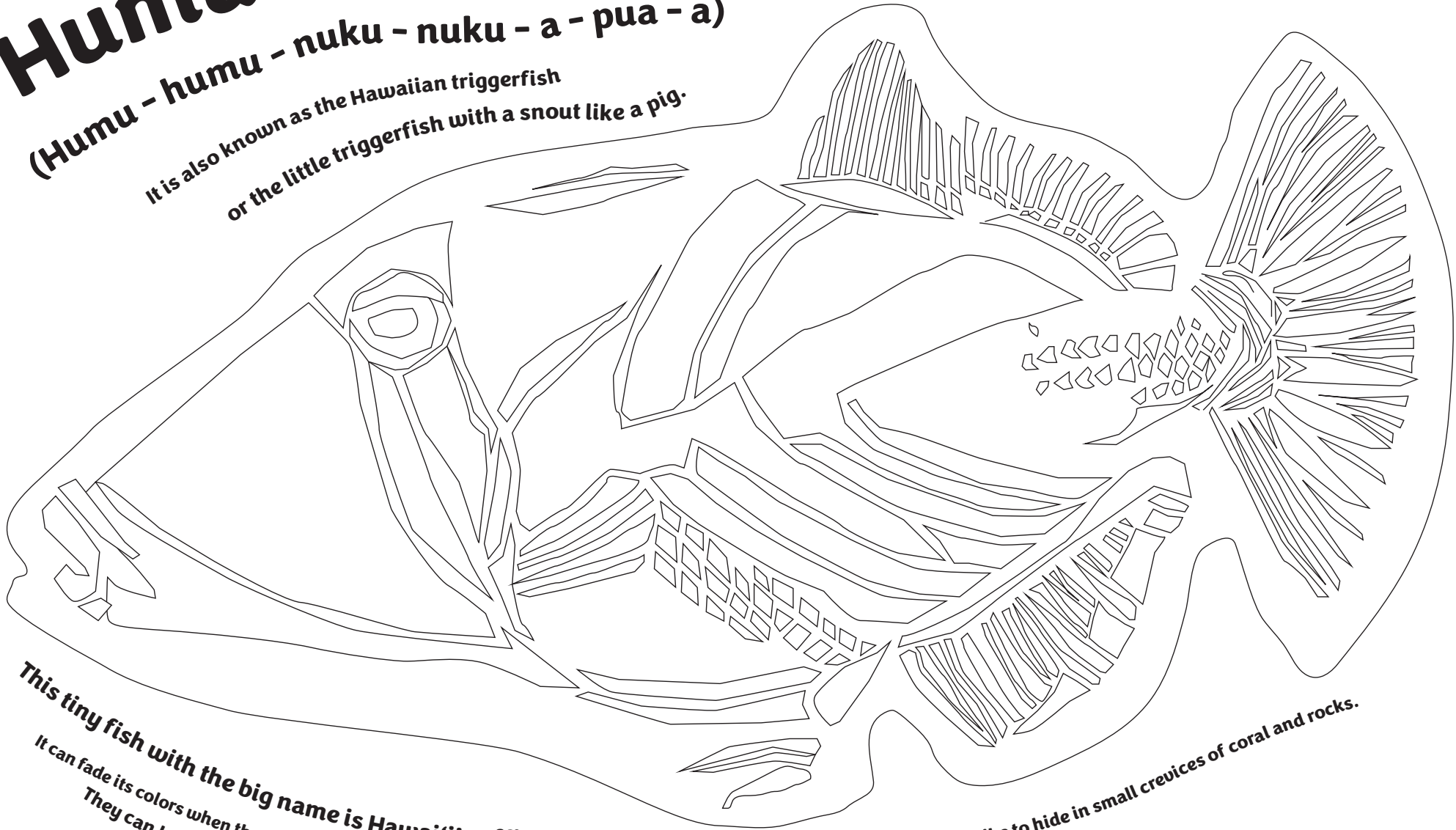


Humuhumunukunukuāpua'a

(Humu - humu - nuku - nuku - a - pua - a)

It is also known as the Hawaiian triggerfish
or the little triggerfish with a snout like a pig.



This tiny fish with the big name is Hawai'i's official state fish.

It can fade its colors when threatened or sleeping... this little fish sleeps on its side.

They can lock their spines to protect themselves from predators, making it difficult to pull the fish from crevices that it hides in.

The triggerfish live in reefs and like to hide in small crevices of coral and rocks.
